A Little About Estes Park

The free shuttle bus in Estes Park will only be serving the downtown area during the AGM and will not have any drop offs or pick ups at the fairgrounds or community center.

- Registration deadline for the JSBA AGM is May 1st, 2023.
- All Registration documents are fillable PDFs, so you can complete them all digitally if you prefer to not print them and intend to email them back.
- Registration can be emailed or sent in the mail.
- Your Registration costs includes all 5 meals.
- EVERYONE is welcome to attend, regardless of their affiliation with the JSBA.

Things to Know About Bringing Your Sheep

All sheep MUST have a scrapie tag in their ear. All OUT OF STATE entries must have official health certificates with a scrapie statement-for example:

The sheep on this certificate have had no diagnosis or history of Scrapie or any contact with a premises which scrapie has been traced to or diagnosed with in the last five years.

This must be issued by an accredited veterinarian in the state of origin within 30 days prior to the show and a paper copy must be presented at the time the animals are penned. NOTE: May change to “5 days prior to show” at discretion of State Veterinarian in years with vesicular stomatitis outbreaks.

All sheep coming in from out of state must abide by the Health Requirements for Moving Animals Into Colorado <https://www.colorado.gov/pacific/aganimals>

This includes testing Rams older than 6 months for B.Ovis and having an entry permit.

Upon arrival, all animals will be inspected by the EPWM sheep superintendent – Dr Ruehlman. If an animal is showing signs of a contagious disease, including but not limited to: sore mouth, vesicular stomatitis or ring worm, the exhibitor will be asked to keep suspect animals out of the show barn.

Federal Q fever rules state that no ewes that have lambed within 30 days or lambs younger than 30 days old will be allowed to be entered in the show or be allowed in the show barn. Exhibitors with ewes that are close to lambing are strongly advised to leave those animals at home. If those animals lamb while at the show, they will be isolated and/or possibly asked to leave the grounds.

Fleece and Fiber Show

Entry Fee - \$2.50 per fleece



Attached are the check in forms (2 per page). To expedite fleece check-in, these forms can be pre-filled and placed with each fleece. Forms will also be available at the show check-in. Pre-entries are appreciated, but fleeces will be accepted until 4:30 pm on Friday June, 9th at the event.

Please print on white paper and cut into 2 forms. Our judge has requested that the fleeces be entered WITHOUT any breeder or flock names. So, each breeder will be issued a random exhibitor number upon checking fleeces in for the show. Please leave that line blank until that time.

All fleeces must be from sheep owned by the exhibitor. Each individual fleece should be bagged in a clear plastic bag. There should not be anything in the bag besides the fleece and the attached show registration form.

Lamb fleeces may have up to 16 months of growth. All other fleeces shall not have more than 12 months of growth. Each farm/family may have up to three entries per class.

Your hosts have made arrangements with the Superintendent of the Estes Park Wool Market Fleece & Fiber Show to get the Jacob fleeces that are shown in the JSBA AGM Fleece & Fiber Show checked in after their stated deadline so that each fleece may be shown in both shows should the Jacob breeder decide to do so. You MUST register for the EPWM Fleece & Fiber Show separately by their required deadline. That registration information can be found here.
